- * Sweat pants—all sizes



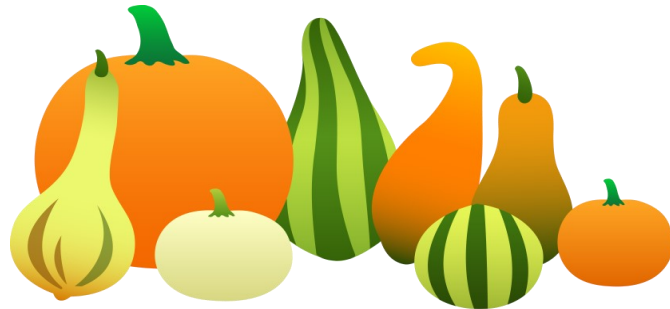

Family Faith Formation Tip

Asking “How was your day?” might get you a one-word answer from your kids. Instead ask, “What were the best and worst parts of your day?” You’ll be surprised by what you learn if you ask this question regularly, and the answers will give you things to pray about together.
