



How can we say *Thanks* to all the folks who responded to God's prompting with prayer and financial support for the building of a K-8 school in Pakistan!

It was exactly **one year ago** today, August 11, that the first \$4000 was sent as down payment for the land. Many friends joined the team to exceed the goal of \$50,000 for both land and school. (\$17,481 for land and \$35,400 for school. Total sent to Pakistan is **\$52,881** as of August 5, 2021) We currently have \$7883.86 remaining in the Roshan account. White boards and student furniture will likely be bought with the remaining donations. The deadline for donations is August 31.

We have looked at this as God's school and give him all the credit for the overwhelming response! Our thanks also must go to the Pakistani Team who faithfully and honestly distributed the money to the workers and skilled professionals who managed to meet the deadline in finishing the construction. Painting will be done when the cement has had ample time to dry. A daily record was kept of where the money went and what was purchased with it. To God be the glory! Your team:
