



## Ministry . . .

**Romans: The Gospel of God’s Grace**  
The book of Romans is the Apostle Paul’s longest and most theological letter. Its main theme is freedom in Christ – why we need it, how it is achieved and what it looks like in everyday life. Plan to join us on Sunday, September 6, as we begin a series on Romans and discover the life-changing truth of the Gospel of God’s Grace.

**Evening Worship Update**  
On Sunday, September 13 the evening worship gathering will once again be provided. The guidelines for this gathering remain the same (ex. 6-feet physical distancing, face masks on entering the facility and on exiting the sanctuary, offering at the doors, sing two songs, etc). The only significant change is the guideline on where to sit in the sanctuary. In the morning, the “open” pews are marked by green ribbons and the “closed” pews are marked by red ribbon. This will be reversed for the evening service so that our cleaning crew does not need to come in prior to the service to clean the sanctuary.


### Family Faith Formation Tip
