

### **Romans: The Gospel of God's Grace**


The book of Romans is the Apostle Paul's longest and most theological letter. Its main theme is freedom in Christ – why we need it, how it is achieved and what it looks like in everyday life. Plan to join us on Sunday, September 6, as we begin a series on Romans and discover the lifechanging truth of the Gospel of God's Grace.

#### **Evening Worship Update**

On Sunday, September 13 the evening worship gathering will once again be provided.
