



#### From the Council Meeting of November 27

- 1. President Bill Cobern opened the meeting with prayer.
- 2. The Shepherding Deacons shared a verbal update of their work including that the Christmas project offering on December 9 is scheduled for the Kalamazoo Gospel Mission Bread Fund and the Christmas Day offering will be for the Kalamazoo Gospel Mission general fund.
- 3. The work of the Administrative Board was reviewed, including the following items:
  - \* Approval was given to propose to the congregation that we change our morning service from 9:30 am to 10 am effective February 3, 2019.
  - The Motion to replace church driveway and parking lot was tabled and a new motion was made, seconded and carried to propose to the congregation the following:
    - \* Obtain the value of Site #2 on 11th Street
    - \* List Site #2 for sale
    - Use the sale proceeds for church property improvements.
  - \* An increase in pulpit supply from \$150 to \$175, effective Jan. 1, 2019 was approved.
  - The 2019 Budget was approved for congregational approval.
  - \* A motion to establish a Long-Range Planning Team was approved. Donn Carlisle agreed to serve as both Chair and Elder Representative; Matt Durian agreed to serve as Deacon Representative; other suggested team members will be contacted.
- 4. The Annual Congregational Meeting was moved from Dec. 9 to Dec. 16 to allow adequate time for the congregation to study the 3 proposals and meet the requirements of our "By-Laws." The agenda will be placed in member mailboxes on Sunday, December 2.
- 5. The October financial report was reviewed.
- 6. Pastor Simon gave a detailed report of his activities in October and November.
- 7. A time of Mutual Censure was exercised.
- 8. The next Council meeting is Tuesday, Januarv 22. 2019.
- 9. Deacon Teri Wager closed the meeting in prayer.
