

COUNCIL REPORT for 11/21/17 MEETING

- Pastor Simon Tuin opened with prayer and lead discussion on Chapters 2 & 3 "Growing Young: 6 Essential Strategies to Help Young People Discover and Love Your Church."
- The Shepherding Elders shared a verbal report of the meeting held earlier that day.
- The Shepherding Deacons shared a verbal update of their work and the meeting held just prior to the Council meeting, including that the Christmas project offering on Dec. 10 is scheduled for World Renew. The deacons will give a report and "thank-you" to the congregation for their generosity at the Congregational Meeting on Dec. 10.
- The work of the Administrative Board was reviewed, including the following items:
- Motion was supported and carried to approve restroom faucet replacements in the amount of \$2,700 to be taken from the Building Fund.
- Building security was discussed and noted that all doors (including main entrance) are now to be locked during services. It was also noted that the Kalamazoo Co. Sheriff Dept. has been contacted for recommendations to enhance security.
- The October financial report was reviewed and will be distributed to the congregation.
- The proposed 2018 Budget was approved and will be presented to the congregation for their review and approval at the Dec. 10 Congregational Meeting.
- Pastor Simon's Sabbatical report was gratefully received and will also be distributed to the congregation for their information. In addition, he provided a detailed report of his activities the past two months.
- Affirmed the agenda for the congregational meeting:
- 1. Approval of revised Articles of Incorporation
- 2. Presentation of proposed 2018 budget
- 3. Pastor Simon's sabbatical report
- 4. Ministry updates & sharing of blessings
