

2020 Dairy Project Report

Thank you for your generous support for rowing Hope Globally and World Renew through the Kalamazoo Area Dairy Growing Project in 2020!

- \$24,623.54 was raised in 2020
- **5** cows were housed, fed and milked by Red Arrow Dairy
- **\$8,859** worth of milk income was generated by these cows
- 3 Kalamazoo area churches involved: Grace CRC, Heritage CRC, Third CRC
- \$7,414.39 was raised by the three churches to cover the feed and depreciation costs for the cows
- \$8,350.15 was contributed by 5 of the dairy's suppliers: Harvey Commodities, Nobis AgreScience, Sennvet, Zeeland Farm Service, and Zoetis
- **14** years of support is greatly appreciated!
- \$377,574.55 has been raised to date
- 6,888 people have been served through your support.

Your support makes a lasting difference for vulnerable families around the world, helping them to provide for themselves and find lasting solutions to hunger. Thank you for joining us in loving our global neighbors! This year your funds will support the Nicaragua Boaco Camoapa and West Africa Programs.



Located in the mountainous central region of Nicaragua, the Boaco Camoapa program works with farmers to identify farming techniques and crops that help them have more resilient livelihoods. Participants are leaning about climate change risk analysis and adaptation planning. Water committee are organized to ensure care of local water sources. Families are leaning to prepare healthier meals including vegetables grown in their own kitchen gardens. They are also learning to preserve fruits and vegetables for later use.



The West Africa program works to improve production of, access to, and use of food in over 70 villages. Training encompasses conservation, agriculture, tree preservation and reforestation, gardening and nutrition, village savings and loans, small business management, raising animals, as well as health and hygiene. 2,400 participants are improving their food security. The local partner, SEL, is a small organization whose goal is to "show everyone love" regardless of their religion or ethnicity, by helping people improve their food security.
