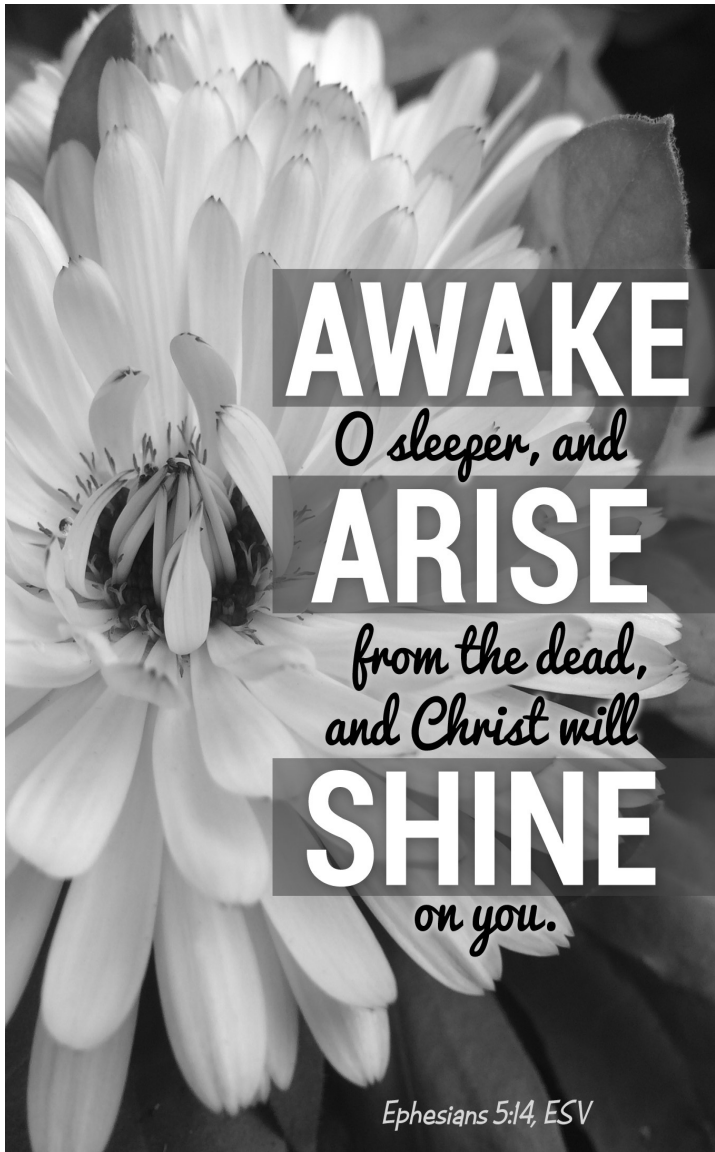

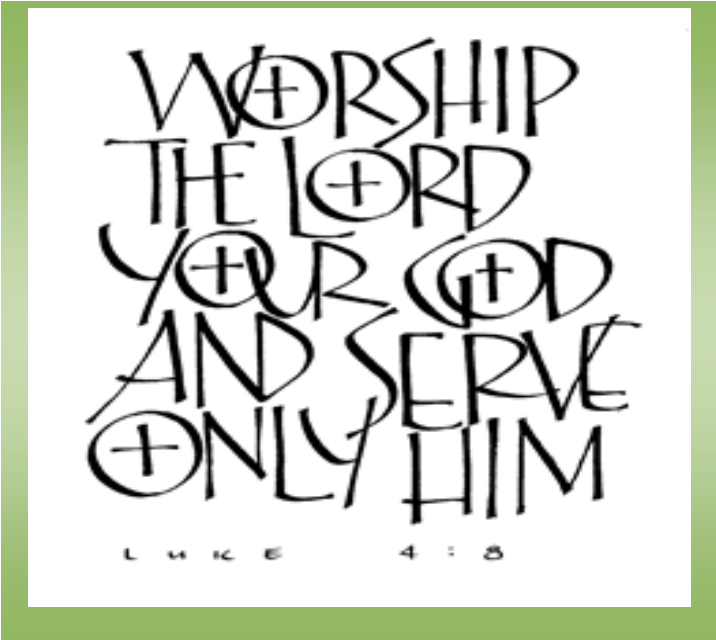
Requested Announcements
