

Council Highlights

Council met this past Tuesday and here are a few highlights:

The shepherding elders gave a verbal report on their ministry. In an effort to strengthen our welcoming and enfolding ministry importance of greeting visitors was emphasized.

The shepherding deacons gave a verbal report on their ministry. The June 30 financial report was reviewed with thanksgiving because of its positive outlook. The 6-month individual giving reports will be in mailboxes on Sunday.

The minutes of the Administrative Board were reviewed and approved by the Council. Noteworthy items include a request to approve the air conditioner chiller repair which was damaged sometime during the winter season. The total cost of the repair will be \$5,337 and all but \$1400 (including \$1000 deductible) is covered by our insurance. Also of note is the removal of the old stove in the kitchen and the installation of new electric stoves, the placement of new banners on the light posts along the church driveway, and plans to upgrade the church website to be mobile interface friendly.

Council received Pastor Simon's written report of his activities including his time at Synod.

Heritage CRC will once again be the host site for the "Back to School Bash" on Saturday, August 27. Information on this event will be posted in the Heritage Happenings.

It was noted that the Fall Carnival is scheduled for Saturday, September 10.

Several members of the council will attend a Leadership Training Event at Calvin College the evening of Tuesday, September 13. These workshops are designed to equip ministry leaders for their work in the church.

Classis Kalamazoo meets at Northern Heights CRC on Sept. 13. A deacon and elder delegate will be assigned to attend with Pastor Simon.

During a time of discussion, it was noted with gratitude how our church family faithfully volunteers of their time; support each other with prayer, cards, food and assistance; and financially supports the church and its outreach.
