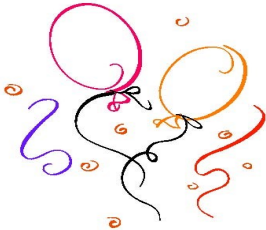
Just a reminder that due to the Holiday weekend, there is no evening worship here tonight.
