



### From the Library...

The theme of our devotional for June is GAR-DENS. In our church family, some devoted vegetable gardeners include Dean Manni, Rich Van Maaren, myself, and perhaps others. There are many flower and ornamental gardeners also in our congregation. As we enjoy the garden colors and the edibles from asparagus and rhubarb through to peaches, plums and pears and the "three sisters" of our Native American culture (beans, corn, and squash), we can also gain Biblical knowledge from the June devotions. Enjoy our Lord's seasonal provision of "our daily bread".

THE DINOSAURS ARE HERE! Do vou know your Velociraptor from your venom-spitting Dilophosaurus? "Guide to Dinosaurs", a new church library book, gives us all the "low-down" on these fascinating creatures. Were there 60 different dinosaur "kinds" on Noah's ark? Which dinosaurs match up with the Behemoth and Leviathan of Job' time (circa 1400 B.C.)? Why does a Cambodian temple (1100s A.D.) have a Stegosaurus carved on its wall? Did the mass extinction of most dinosaurs come from a worldwide Flood, instead of the Evolutionary hypothesis of a killer Asteroid? This 113-page book is full of skeletons, drawings of types of dinosaurs, pictures of those who discovered and named the fossils. Check it out!
