A new Hallmark Living schedule (from July 1 through December 30, 2018) can be found in mail-boxes this morning of those involved in this ministry.

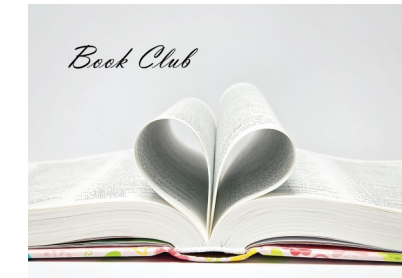

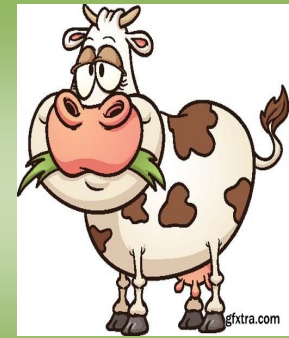
