

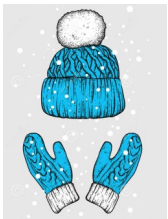

Worship News

This Sunday, November 1, is Communion Sunday. We invite all who have been baptized in the name of the Triune God and confess Jesus as their Savior, to join us at the table of our Lord for Communion. Please be sure to pick up your communion cup before you enter the sanctuary, they are located in the baskets on the table in the lobby.

Children at the Lord's Supper: In January 2014, the elders adopted the practice of welcoming covenant (baptized) children to the table of the Lord through the following steps:

1. The child expresses an interest in participating in the Lord's Supper to a parent(s).
2. The parent(s) discuss with the child what the sacrament means and encourage an age-and-ability-appropriate understanding of the Lord's Table and what it means to be a follower of Christ.
3. The parent(s) are invited to guide their child through a one-week devotional that helps parents explain what the Lord's Supper is all about. A copy is available upon request from an elder and/or pastor.
4. If and when a parent(s) is ready to affirm the child's faith and readiness to come to the table, the parent(s) communicates this to an elder and/or pastor. At the next celebration of the Lord's Supper a special welcome will be extended to the child who is participating for the first time.

If there are any questions, please talk to Pastor Simon or one of the shepherding elders.
