




Please come and help decorate the church for the Christmas season. November 25 & 20, 46-tails coming soon. Ideas

The **Sundays of November 6 & 13** have been designated the INTERNATIONAL DAY OF PRAYER for the Persecuted Church. According to Open Doors USA, in just the last year, there have been:

- Over 360 million Christians living in places where they experience high levels of persecution and discrimination.
- 5.898 Christians killed for their faith
- 5,110 churches and other Christian buildings attacked
- 44,765 believers detained without trial, arrested, sentenced or imprisoned

In countries like India and Turkey, religious identity is increasingly tied to national identity meaning, to be a "real" Indian or a good Turk, you must be a Hindu or a Muslim, respectively. In other countries on the World Watch List (www.opendoorusa.org/christian-persecution/ world-watch-list/), religious identity is closely tied to national identity, and anyone who follows Jesus risks being seen - and persecuted - as a bad citizen.

These numbers are heart-breaking. And yet, they do not tell the whole story. James 1:2-4 says, "Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance." That joy is what we see when we hear and work with Christians all over the world who suffer because they serve Jesus. God cares for His people, and He will never leave of forsake them.
