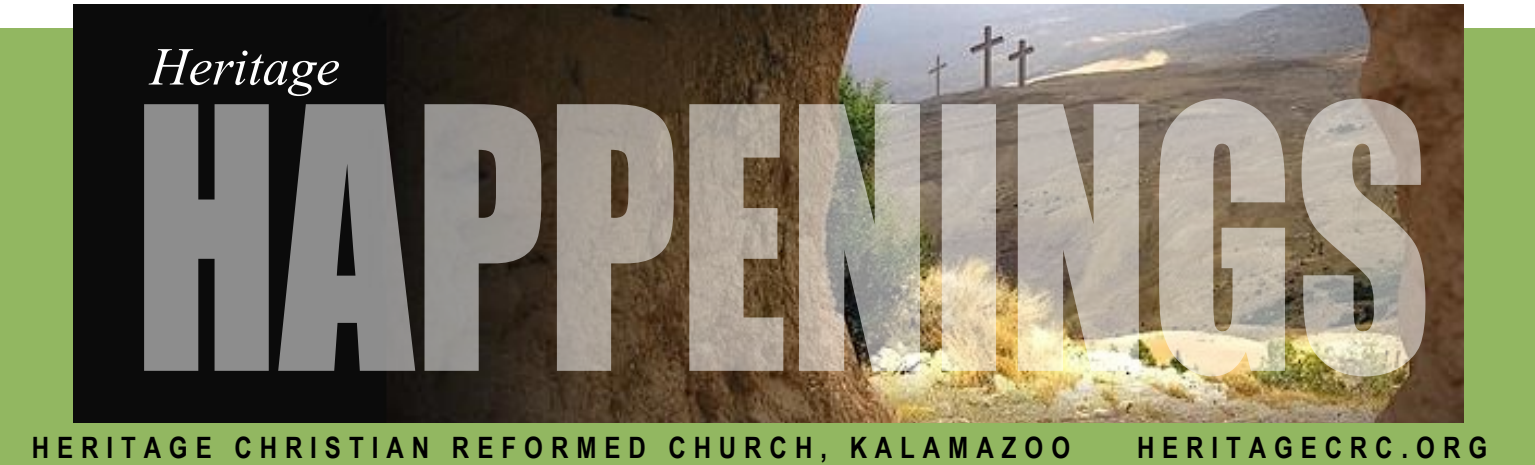

The campers go to 8 different stations during the morning and learn basketball skills at each station along with one station where the kids also hear the message of Jesus Christ. We had 10 total in our group and we were blessed to spend time each morning with the campers. In the afternoons our kids went on some hikes around the Rehoboth campus, ending with a sunrise hike on Friday. We also went into the town of Gallup and watched traditional Indian dances and also had time to do some shopping. On Friday we enjoyed a day away and went to a wolf sanctuary and also went to an ice cave where the temperature is consistently 31 degrees and the ice is 12-15 inches thick year round, this is where the native people stored their food. It was a good week and we are thankful for each person that came with us on the mission trip. We pray that seeds were planted through the camp and that the campers will know Jesus through the camp and through our love as we worked with them. There is so much beauty in New Mexico with all the mountains but we also see so much beauty just walking into our church sanctuary, we are so thankful we can go on our mission trip but we are also so thankful for Heritage Church.
