- Jelly/Jam - cereal and granola bars



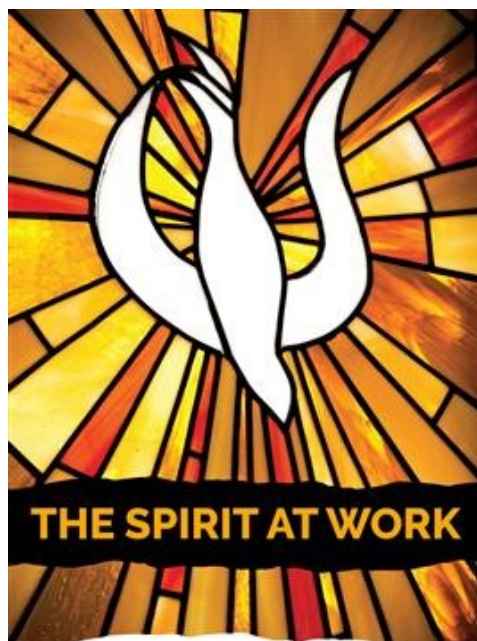
