

This past Sunday the congregation affirmed the following individuals for council: Shepherding Elder: Rick Lingbeek, Shepherding Deacon: Teri Wagner, Administrative Elder: Matt Durian. The installation of new office-bearers will take place on Sunday, May 15.

Council Update: At the recent congregational meeting, the proposal to replace all but part of the East and North portion of the parking lot was approved as well as the plan to fund the project. The total is \$162,500. Using resources from several funds, \$91,975 has already been set aside for this project. We received news this week we were approved for an interest free, 15-year loan of \$30,000 from Classis Kalamazoo. The outstanding balance is \$40,525. On Sunday, May 15 a special collection will be received to begin fundraising for this project.


