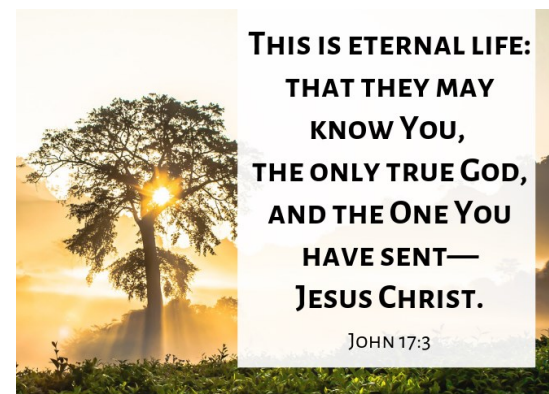

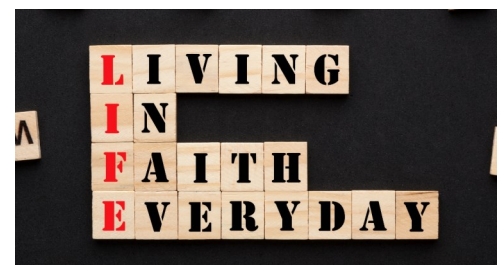
**What's up in Worship**

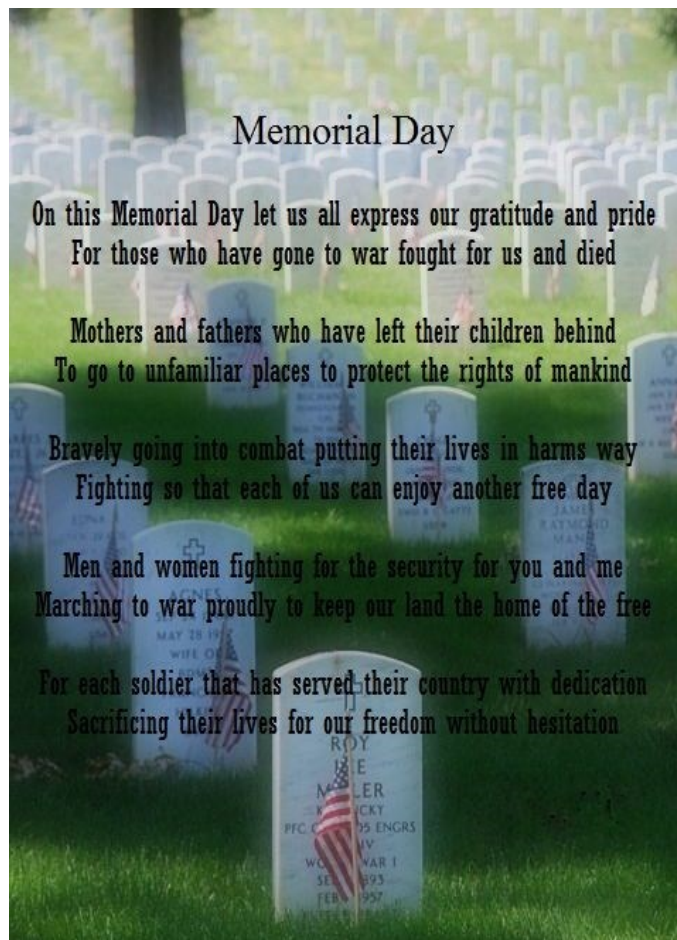
