



#### COUNCIL REPORT - March 28, 2023

- The administrative board reports were reviewed and approved. This included the approval for the preschool to install lockers in the hallway, carpet in one of the classrooms, and a mounted TV in each classroom. Estimates are also being received to replace the shed.
- The shepherding elders presented on their ongoing work in pastoral care to home-bound members. Gratitude was shared for those who have joined the church as new members and the recent profession of faith and baptism.
- The shepherding deacons shared an update on their work of the benevolent ministry to members of the community and gratitude for the financial support of the congregation.
- The council compiled a list of nominees for the office of elder and deacon and sent out letters. Those nominated were asked to respond by Sunday, April 16.
- The council approved the Israel Study
   Tour Fund to receive financial gifts as a
   future opportunity for the pastoral staff
   and family to go to Israel as continuing
   education in ministry. An donation for this

- Pastor Simon gave a detailed report on his activities the past two months.

- A verbal report was given on the March 14 meeting of Classis at Westwood CRC. A highlight of the meeting was a presentation by Rev. Zachary King, General Secretary for the CRCNA.
